Freddie Powell, Jr. Memorial Scholarship Fund

This scholarship was established in memory of Mr. Freddie Powell, Jr., whose generous and selfless service to the people of Cincinnati and the church community is a model for service excellence. This scholarship is open to all persons pursuing a post-secondary degree as described herein below.

The purpose of the Freddie Powell, Jr. Memorial Scholarship Fund is to assist and encourage individuals to advance themselves in post-secondary studies.

The mission of the Freddie Powell, Jr. Memorial Scholarship Fund is to provide financial assistance and hands-on experience to students majoring in the fields of Communications (audio/visual technologies) and/or the Creative and Performing Arts; at an accredited post-secondary institution.

The criteria:

1. Submit a completed application. All applicants must have a grade point average of 3.0 or higher.
2. Provide a copy of the letter of acceptance from a post-secondary institution.
3. **Recipient must agree to a 40-hour internship with Union Baptist Church Media Ministry to be scheduled at the time of acceptance, and in accordance with the Church Calendar within a 6-month period after scholarship announcement.**
4. Scholarship will be announced on Recognition Sunday at the Union Baptist Church of Cincinnati in June.
