

Freddie Powell, Jr. Memorial Scholarship Fund Process

This scholarship was established in memory of Mr. Freddie Powell, Jr., whose generous and selfless service to the people of Cincinnati and the church community is a model for service excellence. This scholarship is open to all persons pursuing a post-secondary degree as described herein below.

The purpose of the Freddie Powell, Jr. Memorial Scholarship Fund is to assist and encourage individuals to advance themselves in post-secondary studies.

The mission of the Freddie Powell, Jr. Memorial Scholarship Fund is to provide financial assistance to students majoring in the fields of Communications (audio/visual technologies) and/or the Creative and Performing Arts; at an accredited post secondary institution.

The criteria:

1. Submit a completed application. All applicants must have a grade point average of 3.0 or higher. **Prior scholarship recipients may also reapply after completing an internship at Union Baptist Church.**
2. Provide a copy of the letter of acceptance and completed enrollment application from a post secondary institution.
3. Applicant selected as finalist *may* be invited to a show case performance, where they will demonstrate their talent.
4. Scholarship will be awarded on Recognition Sunday at the Union Baptist Church of Cincinnati in June.
